

# Craft Stick Insects



## Materials

- Craft sticks
- Glue
- Beads, buttons, googly eyes, pipe cleaners, or pom-poms
- Construction paper

## Instructions

1. Glue three craft sticks together to make a triangle then glue a piece of construction paper on the back to create the body
2. Colour the craft sticks the same colour as the construction paper
3. Cut out various paper shapes like wings, a head, or other decorations
4. Use pipe cleaners for legs and add googly eyes or pom-poms to decorate

# Paper Chain Rainbow



## Materials

- Construction paper
- Glue or washi tape
- Googly eyes, pipe cleaners, or embroidery thread

## Instructions

1. Cut construction paper into strips using different colours
2. Create a loop with a strip and secure with tape or glue then make another loop and lace it through the first—repeat until you have a chain for each colour
3. Cut out a cloud shape and secure each chain to the back
4. Secure a loop of thread or pipe cleaner at the top to hang then add googly eyes or other decorations

# Paper Shapes Garland



## Materials

- Embroidery thread
- Construction paper or patterned scrapbook paper

## Instructions

1. Create a template of your favourite spring shape
2. Trace your template onto paper and cut out as many as you want
3. Arrange the shapes onto the embroidery thread and tie in place

# Tissue Paper Flowers



## Materials

- Tissue paper
- Pipe cleaners or craft sticks
- Buttons

## Instructions

1. Cut out plenty of circles using different colours of tissue paper—the circles can be different sizes and have smooth, jagged, or curvy edges
2. Thread a short piece of pipe cleaner through the holes of 1 or more buttons
3. Thread the circles onto the pipe cleaner from smallest to biggest so the button becomes the centre of the flower—offset the layers to add texture
4. Make a stem using pipe cleaners or crafts sticks and secure in place
