

# Blind Contour Drawing



## Materials

- Drawing material (pencil, markers, crayons, etc.)
- Paper
- Subject (this can be an object or person)

## Instructions

1. Choose an object or a person you wish to draw.
2. Bring the pencil to the paper. Now without looking back down at your hand, begin drawing exactly all the lines you see in the object. Do not lift up your pencil—your drawing should be one continuous line from start to finish.
3. Once you're satisfied take a look at your drawing—the results may surprise you! Add some colour to complete your blind contour.

# Drawing Bubbles



## Materials

- Black paper
- Pencil and colourful drawing material (crayons, pastels, or markers)
- Circular objects

## Instructions

1. From your surroundings, gather circular objects that you can trace. These items can be cups, lids, a roll of tape, or a sharpener.
2. Trace the edge of the circular object with a pencil and go over this line with a white crayon or pastel.
3. Using colourful crayons or pastels, draw lines inside the borders of the circles.
4. Create highlights using a white marker or pastel, drawing lines and dashes in a circular shape.

# Radial Drawing



## Materials

- Drawing material (pencil, marker, crayon, etc.)
- Paper
- Ruler

## Instructions

1. Using a ruler, find the center of your page and mark it with your pencil.
2. Create a shape of your choosing at the center point that you have marked.
3. Draw repeated lines around this initial shape until you have reached the edge of your image.
4. Create variation with the lines by using different kinds of drawing materials.
